



A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

We will celebrate our first Feast Day as St. Paul VI Parish on Sunday, September 26, at an 11:00 Mass in the Parish Center at St. Mary. Bishop Birmingham, our new Vicar, will preside at the Mass and I will be installed as your Pastor, Fr. Matt Nemchausky will be presented as your Associate Pastor, and the new parish staff, Parish Pastoral Council, and Finance Council members will be presented. In anticipation of this Feast of St. Paul VI, we will pray a Novena to St. Paul VI.

Many of us have prayed novenas for various intentions before. Perhaps you have prayed the Novena of the Sacred Heart which is prayed on nine first Fridays or Las Posadas which is celebrated from December 16-24th to commemorate the journey of Mary and Joseph from Nazareth to Bethlehem. Many have prayed the Novena to St. Peregrine the patron of cancer patients.

The Novena to the Holy Spirit which is prayed between Ascension Thursday and Pentecost recalls the disciples' gathering in the upper room and praying. This is often considered to be the first novena.

Some may not be familiar with this form of devotional prayer. Some may ask what is a novena? A novena is an ancient tradition of Christian prayer, consisting of special prayers or services on nine successive days. Novenas are often prayed in preparation for a special feast day or a particular intention.

The Novena in anticipation of the Feast of St. Paul VI will be prayed for all the people of St. Paul VI Parish and for whatever intentions are in the hearts of the participants. Our novena will be led by one of our priests or deacons but there is another special dimension to our evenings together. Dr. Geraldine Rohling, Archivist and Curator for the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C., will be our guest speaker. Dr. Rohling will address us each evening as she is an expert on St. Paul VI and has wonderful insights and stories about him to tell. She will also bring items from the Basilica collection that are memorabilia of St. Paul VI for us to see and reflect on the life and virtues of our patron.

Please join us for a Novena each evening from September 17-25 at Mater Christi Church from 7:00-8:00 PM. I know you will be enriched by the evenings and that our parish will be enriched by your prayers.



What is Alpha?

St. Mary had several Alpha groups. Last Spring, we had an Alpha program that brought together St Mary, Mater Christi, and St Hugh parishioners. The experience of Alpha is meant to fan the flames of our faith and to invite others to experience our faith community.






Alpha has spread across the globe and over 30 million people have done Alpha. A few years ago, the Archdiocese of Chicago recommended Alpha to re-energize parishes and to exercise our mission to share the Good News of Jesus. The Alpha experience is simple: a small group of 8-10 people gather with a host and a helper, both of whom have been trained. Food is shared, followed by a video on a key aspect of faith. The host then leads the group in discussion. The meeting lasts about two hours.


