





A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

On July 27th, parishioners interested in the new Parish Pastoral Council met in the Marian Room at Mater Christi church. There were 38 of us gathered to hear how the Council will work by focusing on the mission of the parish and identifying the needs to which we are called to respond.

As the meeting began, we shared our hopes and dreams for St. Paul VI Parish. It reminded me of the Scripture passage from the prophet Joel when the Lord says, "It shall

come to pass I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions." The women and men—older and younger—who came together at Mater Christi, have wonderful dreams and visions for our parish. As one parishioner said, "The Holy Spirit is at work already!"

Some of the dreams voiced were that we would really be united, that we would have new ideas for service and community-building and that we would bring out the best of the three communities that have united. Other people dream that we will listen to needs and be peacemakers, that we will be an inclusive, warm, welcoming parish and encourage active participation. Many participants dream that we will be a vibrant parish which will attract young people, get them involved and call forth their gifts. We want to have strong religious education, teen and young adult ministries that will have young people wanting to belong.

Other dreams that were spoken were that we will, with the Spirit's help, do the work of the Holy Spirit. We dream, others said, that we will bring people back to church and invite those who seek Jesus. We dream that at St. Paul VI Parish, everyone will be fed by the gospel and all will find ways to give of themselves.

Do you share some of these dreams? Do you have other dreams and visions of what we can be together? What gifts do you have to help make those dreams a reality?

At the conclusion of the meeting, I was wondering what makes a parish warm and welcoming, vibrant, inclusive, and able to share the Good News? I remembered a line from author Max DePree, "An organization can never be what I as an individual refuse to be." St. Paul VI parish will be what each of us makes it. Then, as one participant said, "We will be awesome!"





ALPHA

St. Paul VI the new parish that combines St. Hugh, Mater Christi and St. Mary is about to embark on a journey together to fan the flames of our faith and to invite others to experience our faith community.

Alpha started in 1977 in England. People no longer assumed that God was true, or the Bible was trustworthy. People were asking what was real. The founding pastor, Nicky Gumbel, designed Alpha as a "place" of hospitality, and a safe environment for people to voice their questions and express their points of view whatever those might be.

Alpha has spread across the globe and over 30 million people have done Alpha. A few years ago, the Archdiocese of Chicago recommended Alpha to re-energize parishes and to exercise our mission to share the Good News of Jesus.

The Alpha experience is simple: a small group of 8-10 people gather with a host and a helper, both of whom have been trained. Food is shared, followed by a video message. The host then leads the group in discussion. The meeting lasts about two hours.

Alpha has changed individuals and parishes across the world! The program will be held on Thursdays from 6:30-8:30 PM. The start date is September 23rd and will be held at the Marian Room of Mater Christi Church 2401 S 10th Ave. North Riverside. The program runs for 10 weeks and includes a retreat experience.



Catholicism and the COVID-19 Vaccine

The Vatican's doctrinal office, the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith (CDF), has determined that it is "morally acceptable" for Catholics to take these vaccines against the COVID-19 Virus. Their determination is deeply rooted in the Catholic moral tradition.

The CDF also said, "All vaccinations recognized as clinically safe and effective can be used in good conscience with the certain knowledge that the use of such vaccines does not constitute formal cooperation with the abortion from which the cells used in production of the vaccines derive" ... "the morality of vaccination depends not only on the duty to protect one's own health, but also on the **duty to pursue the common good.**"

COVID-19 Recent News

There are two new COVID-19 variants in the United States, delta and lambda. The delta variant is two times more transmissible than the original strain and accounts for 83% of the new coronavirus cases in the United States. Researchers found evidence the delta variant might cause greater severity per infection. The COVID-19 vaccine works against the delta variant.


