

In today's Gospel from Mark, Jesus asks the question, "Who do people say that I am?" The disciples tell Jesus that some say he is John the Baptist, others say he's Elijah or one of the prophets. Then he addresses the question to his disciples, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter responds with his profession of faith, "You are the Christ."

Who do you say Jesus is? That is a central question of our faith. Our belief in and relationship with Jesus is at the heart of the

Catholic religion. Teaching our children about Jesus begins in the family where we share faith and practice what it means to be Jesus' disciples today. We want to grow in our own relationship with Jesus, our own understanding of who he is, and have our children grow in faith too.

Today we celebrate the 95th anniversary of St. Mary School. Parents through 95 years have sent their children to St. Mary School to continue the faith growth begun in the home. We remember the principals and teachers and staff who have served the school through the decades and helped our children to answer who Jesus is. We celebrate today's principal, Ms. Nolazco, the faculty and staff who continue this important mission. Happy Anniversary, St. Mary School!

The religious education program is part of our history too. The first program began in 1906, known then as Sunday School. For 115 years, children who attend public school have been formed in family and their faith development supported by directors and volunteer catechists. Through the years these children learned who Jesus is and today we continue that effort.

Our first SPRED program began in 1973, helping children and adults with special needs to get to know Jesus better. Catechists in the SPRED programs often proclaim that they receive more than they give.

Helping our children to know who Jesus is has always been a priority. But we know that we can't give what we don't have, so continuing our own growth is key to making Jesus part of our family life. Indeed, the whole parish community witnesses to Jesus and what discipleship means, so all of us form each other as well as our children. Alpha at Mater Christi and our parish novena to St. Paul VI are two opportunities for deepening our faith.

"Who do you say that I am?" Jesus asks us today. Clearly, it not just knowing facts about Jesus that can answer his question. We understand that our children need knowledge of Jesus, but also experiences of Mass and the sacraments, times of prayer, belonging to a parish community, opportunities to serve and to see Jesus in those in need. As adults we need these dimensions too if we are to answer "who do you say that I am" not just with words, but with our lives.






