

<u>A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR</u>



St. Paul VI Parish Youth Faith Formation programs begin this weekend. We are delighted to have 287 young people in our K-8 program. **Our SPRED groups will begin with a kick-off on October 9 after the 5:00 pm Mass at Mater Christi church**. It is exciting to have a facility, the Saint Hugh Faith Formation Center, dedicated to serving these young people and their families.

Today the Church celebrates Catechetical Sunday, a day when we recognize all the gifted and generous catechists who have embraced their call to share the faith. They give of their time and of themselves to ensure the faith is faithfully presented and that it touches the minds and hearts of those they catechize. We have catechists in our RE, SPRED, at our school, but we honor too our RCIA catechists, those who do preparation for parents for the baptism of their babies, those who prepare couples for the Sacrament of Matrimony. We honor all of them today!

Our dedicated catechists build on the faith foundation given by parents and grandparents, siblings, and extended families. As families, we don't "teach classes" as in formal religious instruction. Families embody the faith in their words and actions and in their witness to Jesus in all they do. Our parish family too is a "living catechesis"—forming us through liturgy and prayer, through formal catechesis and through service to those in need.

The theme the Church has chosen for this Catechetical Sunday is, "Say the Word and My Soul Shall Be Healed." These words have their roots in Scripture when the centurion approached Jesus and asked him to heal his servant. Jesus says he will come to the centurion's house and heal his servant. The centurion replies, "Lord, I am not worthy to have you enter under my roof; only say the word and my servant will be healed." These words are very familiar to us as we pray them at Mass. Like the centurion, we acknowledge our unworthiness and yet, like him, we seek healing. Jesus praised the faith of the centurion and his servant was healed.

Catechists help children, youth, and adults to know Jesus better, to deepen their faith in him, to experience his healing power in their own lives.

In today's Gospel, Jesus places a child amid the 12 apostles. He put his arms around the child and said, "Whoever receives one such child as this in my name, receives me..." Thank you, catechists, for receiving our children, youth and adults for recognizing the Christ in them. Thank you for your own continued growth in faith, for the healing you offer when those you catechize are hurting, for the joys you share with them and the hope you give them in knowing they are never alone.

Please pray for our catechists and all the families that they serve. They have taken seriously today's Gospel when Jesus calls his disciples to be "servant of all." May we all follow their lead!





college in Austin TX where I acquired the very useful expression "y'all," as well as a bachelor's and a master's degree in Voice.




