



#### A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER TOM

In today's gospel from Mark, we witness Jesus' healing power. Note that it says, "people brought to him a deaf man who had a speech impediment." How often those with an illness were brought to Jesus by others. We too can bring others to Jesus through our prayers, our words, our witness of life, and the hopefulness that faith gives us.

Then we hear Jesus speak to the deaf man: "Ephphatha." be opened! I think Jesus asks us too to be opened. Sometimes, due to age or illness, we can become deaf. Sometimes we may choose to be deaf—to not hear what is challenging or unpleasant or what we don't want to listen to.

Be opened! Jesus says. Be opened to hear God's word in liturgy and in our prayer, opened to hear the concerns and needs of our neighbors and our world. This openness is not just about our ears but includes openness of hearts as well. It isn't always easy to be opened to new people, new ideas, opinions that are not our own, and the changes that openness may require of us.

It is wonderful to see there is so much openness among the people of St. Paul VI Parish! The new staff has been opened to working together and attending to the ministries of the parish. The new

Parish Council met for their first formation session and will be opened to each other and the needs of our parish and communities. The new Evangelization Animators Team met and is opened to each other and the mission of the church in our parish. The three women's groups had their first gathering and are opened to the changes required to become one.

The Novena to St. Paul VI, September 17-25, 7-8 P.M. at Mater Christi church will be an opportunity for all of us to be opened to learning about our patron and imitating his example of care for the church and the world. The St. Paul VI Feast Day Mass, September 26, 11:00 at St. Mary Parish Center, is a time of openness to the Holy Spirit and to one another. The Ministry Fair after Mass is a chance to open our hearts to serve our parish and those in need by joining a ministry or organization. The reception afterward is a perfect place to open our ears and minds and hearts as we get to know one another better.

Openness in relationships is a two-way street. Jesus defined what our primary relationships are to be: God and neighbor. Who or what are we called to be opened to? What graces and blessings might come if we are opened? St. Teresa of Calcutta said, "The openness of our hearts and minds can be measured by how wide we draw the circle of what we call family." Ephphatha!



#### Latino Advisory Council Needs You

St. Mary, St. Hugh, and Mater Christi have for close to a century been very welcoming faith communities to all who enter their doors. In the new composition of the parish as St. Paul VI, the parish demographics have not only changed but also the ethnic composition has changed. #### El Consejo Latino de Nuestra Nueva Parroquia

Santa María, San Hugo y Mater Christi han sido durante casi un siglo comunidades de fe muy acogedoras para todos los que entran por sus puertas. En la nueva composición de la parroquia como San Pablo VI, la demografía de la parroquia no solo ha cambiado, sino que también ha cambiado la composición étnica. Tanto Riverside como North Riverside son más del 20% latinos. En la comunidad de Lyons que rodea la parroquia de St. Hugh, la comunidad es más del 50% latina. El crecimiento de la Iglesia en los Estados Unidos se ve en las comunidades latinas con profundas raíces históricas del catolicismo.

Para discernir cuáles son las necesidades de las familias latinas en nuestra parroquia recién formada, el liderazgo parroquial me ha encargado la formación de un grupo asesor de liderazgo latino. El enfoque de grupos llevará a cabo algunas sesiones de escucha sobre las necesidades de las familias latinas y recomendará iniciativas pastorales al liderazgo pastoral de la parroquia.


