



### A message from our Pastor



The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy which comes from the Second Vatican Council reminds us of the importance of music in the liturgy. Sacred music is holy, "adding delight to prayer, fostering oneness of spirit...investing the rites with greater solemnity."

Siobhan Maguire, Director of Liturgy, has served St. Mary and now St. Paul VI ensuring our liturgies are prayerful, unifying and beautiful. Siobhan will be leaving our parish and I want to express our gratitude to her for not only doing her ministry but taking on

additional responsibilities with the loss of our music director and bereavement coordinator. Siobhan has provided formation for our liturgical ministers and worked with our cantors, choir, and ushers/greeters to unify our legacy parishes while honoring what each one brings. Thank you, Siobhan for your commitment to our parish and its people in these covid and short-staffed times.

We will continue the process which Siobhan began, to search for a Music Minister. The search committee is in place and we have advertised far and wide to find the right person. Meanwhile, be assured that our Masses will continue to be enhanced with music which helps us to pray, unites us, and be an integral part of our liturgical celebrations.

Jeanine Watylyk and our weekend accompanists will continue to provide our sacred music. Yet, the finest liturgical music is not complete without the assembly, without each of us. The *Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy* goes on to say, "To promote active participation, the people should be encouraged to take part by means of acclimations, responses, psalmody, antiphons and songs, as well as by actions, gestures and bearing."

These covid times have meant many of our parishioners do not feel safe going out or gathering for Mass. Fortunately, though not ideally, we have been able to livestream Masses. I encourage those who view the Mass at home to really participate. Sing with us, respond with us, sit and stand and kneel with us. Perhaps set a simple table by your TV or monitor, place a crucifix and a candle and your Bible. We will feel the strength of your praying with us and our connection with the Lord and one another will grow.

Please pray, in thanksgiving for Siobhan, in gratitude to Jeanine and all of our liturgical ministers and musicians. And pray that the Lord will send us a Music Minister who will continue the good work begun at St. Paul VI Parish.

### A message from our Associate Pastor



Annually the Catholic Church, along with many other Christian churches throughout the world, celebrates the "Week of Prayer for Christian Unity" from January 18 – 25. We again turn to Philip Kosloski from *Aleteia* to help us better understand this week.

In recent years it is always explained that this week concludes on the feast of the Conversion of St. Paul on January 25. However, it is often forgotten that this week began on a feast of St. Peter, called the Chair of St. Peter at Rome, once celebrated on January 18.

Many Anglicans continue to celebrate a similar feast on that day called the Confession of St. Peter, focusing on the confession of faith that St. Peter gave in support of Jesus' divinity.

The choice to begin a week of prayer for Christian Unity on January 18 was a deliberate one, made by Fr. Paul Wattson, regarded as the "founder" of this week.

Octave of Prayer for Christian Unity

A 2008 article in <u>L'Osservatore Romano</u> explains how it came about.

Fr. Wattson's English friend Spencer Jones suggested that there be an annual day of prayer and preaching in the office of the papacy. He mentioned that June 29, the Feast of St. Peter, would be a very appropriate day for this devotion.

Replying to Rev. Jones on 30 November 1907, Fr. Paul wrote: "The 'Peter sermon' suggestion is fine. In addition to that, what do you think of inaugurating a Church unity week beginning with St. Peter's Chair at Rome, 18 January, and ending with St. Paul's Day? "This became known as the Octave of Prayer for Christian Unity and was eventually approved by Pope Pius X in 1916.

The week, framed by these two feasts, highlights the foundation of Christian unity, built firmly on the faith of St. Peter and strengthened by the writings and example of St. Paul.

Pope Francis announced that Irenaeus will be named a Doctor of the Church, with the title "Doctor of Unity."

Below is a prayer asking the intercession of St. Irenaeus for Christian unity, a unity established through peaceful dialogue.

O God, who called the Bishop Saint Irenaeus to confirm true doctrine and the peace of the Church, grant, we pray, through his intercession, that, being renewed in faith and charity, we may always be intent on fostering unity and concord. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God. for ever and ever.



It was huge but luckily benign, and 2 days after surgery, I went to stay at a rehab facility and learned to walk and talk again. Sometimes I feel like I should go back for more training! Last June, I got engaged to Mike, the most amazing man I have ever met. I try to live my life by this quote: "The noblest art is that of making people happy," PT Barnum. I have been so very blessed, and I make sure to thank God every day for it. No joke.:)
