### A message from our Pastor



Advent is nearly over, and the anniversary of Christ's birth is almost here. It's too early perhaps to say Merry Christmas, we still have preparations to make in our parish, our homes, and our hearts. The final days of Advent can be rich ones for our hearts and spirits as we ready ourselves for the celebrations of Mass, and dinner, and gift exchanges.

The anniversary of Christ's birth, like other birthdays, is not just about "Oh, yes, you were born and we're glad about that." Every birthday is

about what a person has brought throughout their years, whether it has been 4 years since their birth or 54 or 84. This Christmas we celebrate Christ's two-thousand twenty-first birthday. Even focusing on the baby in the manger in our Christmas creches, we can't help but remember his life and all he taught us, and we are aware that there is the shadow of the cross even at his birth. And we know there is a glorious resurrection in his future too!

We will hear the Christmas story again as we have each year, yet we are different this year—having experienced joys and sorrows, successes and losses, births, and deaths. So, the Christmas story speaks to us anew. Children from our religious education program and school will present a Christmas pageant. A new generation will perform the story and help us to remember the innkeepers and shepherds and angels and Mary and Joseph and the baby lying in the manger.

Whatever other Christmas stories we see and hear, whether the traditional "A Christmas Carol" or "It's a Wonderful Life" or a newer version, the Gospel story is the foundation. All the other stories of love and conversion and giving find their source in the story of God's love becoming incarnate in his Son, Jesus.

We have almost a week left to prepare. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is a good way to prepare and is available on Monday evening, December 20, 6-6:45 at both of our churches. There is still time to give to those who are in need, still time to mend relationships, still time to show God's love to those we meet.

The Christmas story isn't the end, it's just the beginning, and Jesus, once born in Bethlehem lives today, Emmanuel, God with us, is present in the liturgy, in God's word, in the sacraments, in the community of faith. The good news that the angels proclaimed to the shepherds is alive among us as we respond to all that Jesus taught. The good news is that Jesus was not only born in Bethlehem but that he will come again in glory and we have this Christmas and every day to "prepare the way of the Lord."

May all the blessings of the Christmas season be yours!

### A message from our Associate Pastor



We have just begun our *O Antiphons* on Friday. Fr Jacob Bertrand Janczyk OP helps us better understand this tradition. Since the 8th century, these chants have been sung at the beginning of the Magnificat each evening from December 17 through December 23.

The season of Advent is full of mystery and anticipation. During these weeks, the Church's liturgy leads the faithful patiently, yet deliberately, through the prophecies of the Old Testament, particularly the prophet Isaiah, to the silence and beauty of the Nativity. Our incarnate Lord, lying in a manger, wrapped in swaddling clothes, is the fulfillment of all hope, and these

last days of Advent are ushered in by the great *O Antiphons* — seven antiphons, or short chants, that is sung at the beginning of the *Magnificat* each evening at Vespers (Evening Prayer) from December 17 through December 23. The *O Antiphons* have been chanted in the Church since at least the 8th century. There are many levels to the symbolism and foreshadowing of the antiphons. Individually, they each speak on their own, addressing our Lord by a different title or name given to him in Old Testament prophecies, imploring him to come and save his people. These antiphons are called the "*O Antiphons*" because each chant begins with a great cry, "*O* …":

- Sapientia O Wisdom
- O Adonai O Lord
- O Radix Jesse O Root of Jesse
- O Clavis David O Key of David
- O Oriens O Dayspring
- O Rex Gentium O King of the Nations
- O Emmanuel O God with Us

Collectively, they speak too. Looking at the titles, we find an acrostic. Taking the first letter of each antiphon, working in reverse, we see the Latin words *ERO CRAS*. Literally, these words translate to, "Tomorrow I will be," or perhaps more appropriately for Advent and the impending Nativity, "Tomorrow I will come."

The text of each antiphon is scriptural and prophetic—the words of the chant are all based on passages from Isaiah that introduce us to the coming Christ-child. It seems every Christian knows the hymn setting of the *O Antiphons*: "O Come, O Come Emmanuel." Over the next seven days of Advent, we will dive into each of these antiphons with the help of the pope and outstanding preacher, St. Leo the Great (d. 461), whose 21-year pontificate Pope Benedict XVI called, "Undoubtedly one of the most important in the Church's history."

No matter the form in which we know the antiphons, these remaining days of Advent should with the help of these beautiful and ancient chants—draw our minds and hearts to the King of Kings as we explore our Catholic tradition and prophecy from of old, joyfully awaiting the coming of our Savior.



#### Empower Illinois Tax Credit Scholarship Matching Donation Program Begins Dec. 1, 2021

The Archdiocese of Chicago has once again secured matching donors for the Empower Illinois Scholarship Program. St. Mary School will receive an additional \$2 for every dollar that you contribute between Dec. 1, 2021 and Jan. 10, 2022 (when funds typically run out). Here's how the program works:

1. **REGISTER** with the State of Illinois at <u>mytax.illinois.gov</u>, unless you already have an online account. It usually takes 10-14 days to receive a letter with the ID number required to set up an account, so click on the "Sign up Now!" button in the Login box to start the process as soon as possible.

2. **RESERVE** your tax credit for the current calendar year (2021 if you donate in Dec and 2022 if you donate in Jan.). Once your account is set up, log into your online account at <u>mytax.illinois.gov</u> (Empowerillinois.org will eventually take you to the same page.). Click on the link to your individual account under the "Accounts" tab. Then, under "I Want to" in the top right corner of the page, select "Contribute to Invest in Kids". Navigate through the form, selecting Cook County, Empower Illinois as the scholarship granting organization, and the amount you will be donating (to all schools). **You will have the opportunity to select St. Mary School when you make your donation.** You will then receive your Contribution Authorization Certificate under your <u>mytax.illinois.gov</u> account correspondence tab almost immediately.

3. **DONATE**: Make your donation between Dec. 1, 2021 and Jan. 10, 2022 (So that we can get our 2:1 matching funds). You will receive 75% of your donation that can be used as a tax credit on your Illinois tax bill. Our goal this year is to secure the full \$100,000 in matching funds available to each school.
