



BIBLICAL ROOTS OF THE TRINITY

Today's readings show some biblical roots of what Christians would later call the Trinity. Proverbs showcases the role of Wisdom in the work of creation, portrayed as a reality outside of God but integrated into God's work of forming the heavens and the earth. We join the psalmist in sharing Wisdom's delight in God's handiwork: "O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth" (Psalm 8:2). In his letter to the Romans, Paul writes of peace with God through Jesus, and the love of God received through the Holy Spirit, distinguishing God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit while also displaying their abiding unity. Finally, in the farewell discourse from John's Gospel, Jesus—who had earlier spoken of himself as Son of the Father—promises his friends that they will receive the Spirit of truth that will teach and guide them after his departure.

A message from our Associate Pastor



This past Monday, the Monday after Pentecost, we celebrated Mary the Mother of the Church. This title was affirmed by St. Paul VI at the end of the Second Vatican Council. Philip Kosloski of Aleteia has more about this topic.

At the end of the Second Vatican Council, St. Paul VI solemnly proclaimed Mary as Mother of the Church, affirming this ancient title.

While Pope Francis is the pope who instituted the memorial of Mary, Mother of the Church, it was St. Paul VI who affirmed this title at the

end of the Second Vatican Council.

This title can be traced back to the 4th century in the writings of St. Ambrose and can be found in various other writings over the years, especially in the 19th and early 20th centuries.

St. Paul VI made it a point to specifically mention this title at the end of the Second Vatican Council, explaining that bishops, priests and laity were asking him to affirm this ancient title.

By rethinking these close relationships with which Mary and the Church are connected, which are so clearly set out in this Constitution of the Council, they lead us to believe that this moment is the most solemn and the most appropriate to fulfill the vow we have mentioned in end of the last Session and which many Fathers have also made their own, asking us with an insistence that during this Council the maternal mission that the Blessed Virgin Mary fulfills in the Christian people be declared in explicit terms. For this reason, it seems necessary to us that in this public session we officially enunciate a title with which the Blessed Virgin Mary is honored, which has been requested by various parts of the Catholic world and is particularly dear and appreciated to us. St. Paul VI then made an official proclamation of this title, affirming its place in the life of the Church.

[W]e proclaim the Most Blessed Mary, Mother of the Church, that is to say of all the people of God, of the faithful as well as of the pastors, who call her the most loving Mother. And we wish that the Mother of God should be still more honored and invoked by the entire Christian people by this sweetest title. He explains how this title affirms that she who is Mother of God, is also our Mother.

It is therefore with a soul full of trust and filial love that we raise our glance to her, despite our unworthiness and weakness. She, who has given us in Jesus the fountainhead of grace, will not fail to succor the Church, now flourishing through the abundance of the gifts of the Holy Spirit and setting herself with new zeal to the fulfillment of its mission of salvation. Mary is our heavenly mother, and this title emphasizes this connection, assuring us that we are not orphans, but sons and daughters of God and the Virgin Mary.





Did you know that there are more than 4,700 students currently on the waitlist for a tax credit scholarship? These students are waiting for a chance to attend a local Catholic school. Your donation to a tax credit scholarship can help us clear the waitlist and offer more children access to a life-changing Catholic school education. In addition, your donation is eligible for a tax credit of up to 75 percent on your Illinois state income taxes.

We are here to help with the donation process. Apply for a 2022 tax credit and donate to a Scholarship Granting Organization. We are here to guide you through the process. Please contact us at tcs@archchicago.org or 312.534.2617 to speak with the Tax Credit Scholarship Office at the archdiocese.

You can donate to help fund a child's future through the Illinois Tax Credit Scholarship Program, "Invest in Kids," which provides a 75 percent Illinois state income tax credit for your contribution. Individuals are eligible to contribute through a Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) and the funds can be designated to a Catholic school. More than 10,000 scholarships have been awarded since the program began in 2017. However, many students remain on wait lists hoping that a scholarship will help fund their Catholic school education. No donation is too large or small.

Individuals can reserve tax credits through mytax.illinois.gov by following the steps. Renewal donors do not need to register.




Vincentian Reflection


