



THE GIFT OF THE EUCHARIST

Today we hear how Abram encounters Melchizedek, "king of Salem . . . and a priest of God Most High" (Genesis 14:18). Melchizedek appears nowhere else in scripture, but is nonetheless significant. Psalm 110 declares of the great King David, "You are a priest forever, in the line of Melchizedek," a description later given (in the letter to the Hebrews) to Christ as High Priest.

Early Christians saw in Melchizedek's bread and wine the bread and wine of the Eucharist; Paul's account of the Last Supper (in today's second reading) is the oldest one in scripture. In the Gospel, Luke describes Jesus providing bread for a crowd in words similar to Paul's, words still used by the Church: Jesus takes bread, gives thanks, breaks it. Together, these three readings reveal how Christian priesthood, Christ's Real Presence, and the call to serve those in need are all found in the gift of the Eucharist.

A message from our Associate Pastor



This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Our patron St Paul VI has much to say about the real presence. During the Second Vatican Council, Paul VI spoke firmly about the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

One belief of the Catholic Church that is often confusing for many is the teaching that Jesus is truly present under the appearance of bread and wine in the Eucharist. Philip Kosloski from Aleteia has more about the Real Presence. The theological name for this is "transubstantiation," which the Catechism explains: "By the

consecration of the bread and wine there takes place a change of the whole substance of the bread into the substance of the body of Christ our Lord and of the whole substance of the wine into the substance of his blood" (CCC 1376).

This means that while the appearance of bread and wine remains, the substance is changed (through the power of God) completely to the body and blood of Christ.

However, some mistakenly hold that the Eucharist is only a "symbol" of Jesus' presence.

St. Paul VI forcefully rejected this idea and wrote about it in his encyclical, Mysterium Fidei, written during the Second Vatican Council.

The constant teaching that the Catholic Church has passed on to her catechumens, the understanding of the Christian people, the doctrine defined by the Council of Trent, and the very words that Christ used when He instituted the Most Holy Eucharist, all require us to profess that "the Eucharist is the flesh of Our Savior Jesus Christ which suffered for our sins and which the Father in His loving kindness raised again." He went on to reinforce this belief, making it crystal clear that the Eucharist is not merely a symbol.

To these words of St. Ignatius, we may well add those which Theodore of Mopsuestia, who is a faithful witness to the faith of the Church on this point, addressed to the people: "The Lord did not say: This is a symbol of my body, and this is a symbol of my blood, but rather: This is my body and my blood. He teaches us not to look to the nature of what lies before us and is perceived by the senses because the giving of thanks and the words spoken over it have changed it into flesh and blood." St. Paul VI went so far as to warn parish priests to speak boldly about this truth of the Catholic faith.

After the Council of Trent, our predecessor, Pius VI, issued a serious warning, on the occasion of the errors of the Synod of Pistoia, that parish priests did not neglect to speak of transubstantiation, which is listed among the articles of the faith, in the course of carrying out their office of teaching. Above all, Pope Paul VI had a firm belief in the Eucharist and wanted the whole Church to fully understand this great gift to humanity.

Did you know that there are more than 4,700 students currently on the waitlist for a tax credit scholarship? These students are waiting for a chance to attend a local Catholic school. Your donation to a tax credit scholarship can help us clear the waitlist and offer more children access to a life-changing Catholic school education. In addition, your donation is eligible for a tax credit of up to 75 percent on your Illinois state income taxes.



You can donate to help fund a child's future through the Illinois Tax Credit Scholarship Program, "Invest in Kids," which provides a 75 percent Illinois state income tax credit for your contribution. Individuals are eligible to contribute through a Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) and the funds can be designated to a Catholic school. More than 10,000 scholarships have been awarded since the program began in 2017. However, many students remain on wait lists hoping that a scholarship will help fund their Catholic school education. No donation is too large or small.

Individuals can reserve tax credits through mytax.illinois.gov by following the steps. Renewal donors do not need to register.


Faith Formation/ Religious Education
