
the Housing Forward shelter in Oak Park. Members generously donated \$147, and the society paid the \$191 balance.

Burial Project Honors Veterans

Marine Michael Dennis White was the latest U.S. veteran to benefit from the generosity of St. Paul VI parishioners who contributed to our Women's Society's Veterans Burial Fund. Big Mike, as he was called, joined the Marine Corps in 1974 after graduating from high school. He became a skilled shooter and earned several medals. He died Sept. 16, 2022.



We were able to assist Michael's family in this way. They said he had a heart of gold and opened it to everyone. He loved to cook, listen to music, and play games with his family.

Parishioners donated \$2,483 in fiscal year 2021 ending last June, and \$335 more in FY 2022 from July 1-Dec. 31. A total of \$700 was paid out, leaving a current balance of \$2,118. Thanks to all who have supported this project. If you know of a family in need of services, please let us know.
